



**PREVENTION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST
ABORIGINAL WOMEN
CALL FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS
DEADLINE: Tuesday, June 30th, 2009 by 4pm**

The Women's Directorate will consider all funding proposals which have included the following:

- Name of the applicant group (must be an Aboriginal women's organization or committee of Aboriginal women and the project must be developed and administered by Aboriginal women)
- Contact person for the project (name, phone number, and email)
- Budget – you may apply for up to \$25,000 for one year projects and \$50,000 for two-year projects (two-year proposals are being accepted this year on a pilot basis only)
- Partners- who are the other organizations, governments, or individuals who support your project financially or in other ways (attach letters of support)
- A description of the project including:
 - project title
 - a description of what you want to do and how it will address preventing violence against Aboriginal women
 - what long term impact in your community you are hoping for
 - how you will actively involve participants or community members over time (versus one workshop with no planned follow up, i.e. sustainability)
 - how you will make sure your project is safe for all participants
 - how you will evaluate the project and share what you have learned
